

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters scholarships

The Vice Chancellor has directed that the attention of Ebonyi State University staff and students desiring to study abroad for Master's degree be drawn to this call for application for Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters Scholarship 2022.

About Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters scholarships

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters are high-level and integrated study programmes, at master level. The programmes are designed and delivered by an international partnership of higher education institutions (HEI) from different countries worldwide. There are 149 programmes to choose from. The scholarships are offered to the best-ranked student applicants worldwide annually, no nominations, no quotas. Over 500 Nigerians have benefited from this scholarship scheme over the past two decades, and Nigeria emerged the top country of Africa with most selected students in 2021.

Funding

The scholarships cover the cost of a student's participation in the programme, travel and a living allowance.

Eligibility

Students at master's level from all over the world can apply. You must have a bachelor's degree (first degree) or be in your last year of bachelor studies and graduate before the master's programme starts.

Duration of the programme and application period:

Duration: 1 to 2 academic years, Application period: October to January each year.

Type of degree awarded:

Either a joint degree (i.e. one single degree certificate issued on behalf of at least two higher education institutions) or multiple degrees (i.e. at least two degree certificates issued by two higher education institutions of the consortium).

How to apply:

Application is on individual basis. Institutional nomination is not required. Applicants are to consult the programme website at <https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/opportunities/individuals/students/erasmus-mundus-joint-masters-scholarships> and follow the steps of the online application process. The programme website also contains all the information you need on content, entry requirements and the list of universities for you to choose.
